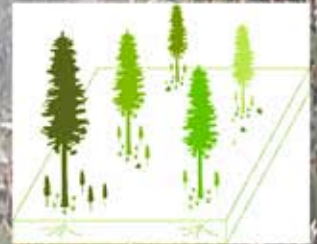
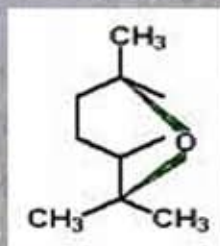
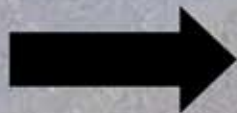
## Integrative Role of Plant Secondary Metabolites in Ecological Systems
